


Welcome to Maritime Aviation

Heliport Design Consultancy (e.g. to ICAO Doc. 9261)

We provide a full heliport design service from the initial design stages of a new-build or refit project. Different types of vessel are required to meet a range of regulatory requirements and recognised industry standards, such as the REG-YC and ICAO Doc. 9261 – Heliport Manual.

We have the training and experience providing Subject Matter Expertise (SME) to a range of private & commercial superyacht clients in the provision and application of maritime aviation support facilities and operations.

In addition to advising on regulatory requirements, we also consult on the ship's helicopter facilities, aviation support services and the practical implications and operational impact of different heliport design configurations.

Aviation Facilities

On Board Operational Helicopter Support Facilities

Operating helicopters at sea requires a range of aviation support services to be provided onboard. If these are not considered at the design phase of a build or refit project, the effectiveness of the helicopter service is likely to be compromised and the efficiency of the helicopter operations conducted onboard will be reduced.

We have extensive experience of operating helicopters at sea in a range of environments, from guest pleasure flights to Polar expeditionary flights. We understand the facilities required to support helicopters, including:

- Helicopter refuelling/defuelling systems
- Helicopter security, protection & hangarage
- Routine helicopter engineering maintenance equipment

Helicopter Type, Registration & Crew Selection

Selecting an inappropriate helicopter type, aircraft registry or helicopter crew for the intended flying operations, will limit the effectiveness of the helicopter service and ultimately compromise the clients' requirements.




To ensure regulatory compliance, we provide full 1st, 2nd & 3rd party independent audits of clients' aviation assets and facilities, including:

We audit suppliers on behalf of our clients against any defined international standard including ISO 9001 and the aviation standard AS 9100.

Aviation Safety Management

Managing Helicopter Risk Onboard

Helicopter operators are required to manage the risks associated with flying helicopter and this is further complicated when operating them at sea from ships. Just as the vessel will have its own Safety Management System (SMS), the aircraft will also have its own.

We are able to provide full aviation risk and safety management support to vessels, using our specialist knowledge and experience of operating helicopter at sea, to undertaking a range of tasks based on the vessel owner's operational requirements, including:

- Aviation Capability Reviews (ACRs)
- Aviation Safety Audits (ASA) inc. risk assessments
- Hazard identification & hazard log production

Heliport Operations Manuals

Helicopter Support & Maintenance Services

The ISM Code requires Operations Manuals to be provided for all tasks which are required to be performed by personnel onboard the vessel.

Our bespoke, dedicated Shipboard Heliport Operations Manuals are based on comprehensive Aviation Safety Audits (ASAs) and designed to augment the ship's Safety Management Systems (SMS). Our manuals cover the full scope of a ship's flying operations on board, including:

- Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)
- Emergency Operating Procedures (EOPs)
- Helicopter guest transfers & other helicopter roles
- Helicopter refuelling/defuelling
- Environmental operations (e.g. Polar/Arctic regions)



Industry-Approved Heliport Crew Training

Shipboard heliport crew play a vital role in ensuring safe flying operations onboard. We are approved by the UK MCA to provide all 4 MCA Heliport Safety Training courses:

- Helicopter Landing Officer (HLO)
- Heliport Procedures & Emergency Response (effectively 'Heliport Deck Assistant', HDA)
- Heliport Firefighting
- Helicopter Refuelling

We have also designed 2 Aviation Awareness courses for:

- Captains and Chief Officers
- Non-heliport crew members

These to provide practical advice on safety critical elements of onboard helicopter operations.

Our Training Locations

We have built-in flexibility in the way we deliver our MCA-approved training to our clients. Most of our courses involve a mixture of theory-based learning, followed up by practical-based training, which we are able to deliver at any of the following locations to suit the client:

- Onboard the client's vessel, anywhere in the world, using onboard facilities to train the crews
- Ashore at suitable training venue at a convenient location for the client (we may be able to deliver live firefighting training at some shore sites – contact us for further details)
- At our UK office in Fareham which includes our practical training area for live firefighting training

Rescue & Firefighting Training Unit (HRFTU)

We have also designed and built a Refuel Training Simulator (RTS) for training delegates who require helicopter refuelling training. Again, this allows us to train crews practically, using a realistic, mobile simulator.
